Arizona Motorsports Park is a racing facility designed by Alan Wilson, featuring a multi-config road course. The track can be used in a 2.23 mile, 16-turn format or split into two separate 1.13 mile courses. In addition to the main track, an 800' x 800' autocross pad and other facilities support driving school operations. The park is situated near Litchfield Park, Arizona, with a strict 94db sound limit since 2010. The facility was built after receiving a special permit in 2001, reopened in 2003, but had its permit revoked in 2004. It resumed operations in 2010 with the imposed sound limit. The park offers various amenities, including a main track, west and east tracks, flagging and observation tower, and safe corner stations. A large driving pad, measuring 800' x 800', is also available, along with adjacent parking areas. The facility caters to SCCA - Phoenix AZ Solo Region events. Events at the Arizona Motorsports Park in Litchfield Park, Arizona are happening regularly. The park is known for hosting SCCA - Phoenix AZ Solo Region events and also features Hooked On Driving - Southwest events.
