Book and quill is a special item in Minecraft 1.19 that lets players write on it using a quill. There are different types of books like normal ones that can be used to trade items or craft bookshelves, and enchanted ones that give powerups. Book and quill stands out because it lets you open it and write on it. When starting the game, you can use this type of book to write about your experiences. It can also be used with redstone components like lecterns. Crafting a book is easy if you have all required items. To craft or obtain book and quill, you need three main items: a normal book, ink sacs from Squids, and feathers from chickens or parrots. Once you get them, place them in the crafting slots to get the item. You can also find books and quills in buried treasure chests with a 18.9% chance of generation. The item has three uses: for writing, as a redstone component, and trading. When using it for writing, players can write anything on each page up to 798 characters. They can also copy and paste text from other books. To lock the book permanently, you need to press the 'Sign' button and add the title of the book. This item cannot be edited once it's locked. A Book and Quill is an essential item for writing books in Minecraft. For items produced after signing a Book and Quill, see Written Book. A book and quill are necessary for creating written content. When crafting a book and quill, you combine a book, ink sac, and feather. New copies are either "Copy of Original" or "Copy of Copy", depending on the original book type. Copies cannot be copied from one another. Books of the same generation can stack together in a single slot. Writing[] To write in a book, you press the use item button or long-press anywhere on the screen while holding the book and quill. This opens a text editor GUI where you can write up to 100 pages (Java) or 50 pages (Bedrock), with a maximum of 798 characters per page. You can copy and paste into books, but only within the same page limits. Many Unicode characters are available in books for use without issue. In single-player mode, the world pauses while editing a book. Lecterns[] A book or written book on an empty lectern emits redstone signals depending on its displayed page. The signal strength increases up to 15 on the last page. Formatting codes[] For styling text in books, you use formatting codes starting with (section sign). + k creates randomly changing characters + l creates bold text + m creates strikethrough text + n creates underlined text + o creates italic text + 0 - f (hexadecimal) creates colored text + r resets previous styles, making the next line normal. Signing[] To sign a book, press the "Sign" button while in the interface. In Java Edition, it displays the player's name and chosen title upon signing; in Bedrock Edition, any text is allowed as the author, but after signing, the book cannot be edited again, becoming a written book. That implements it, meaning titles cannot be colored or formatted in-game. However, on Linux using the compose key to produce special characters does work. The title of the book can be up to 16 characters long, and the player cannot paste into a title. A "workaround" for the 16-character limitation is to manually rename the book at an anvil, which always costs 1 experience level. This can be done with either a written book or a book and quill both versions will always display the changed name. If a custom name is removed from a written book, it will revert back to the title it was given during the signing process. Minecraft introduced new features for Book and Quill items starting from version 1.2.0beta. These updates allowed players to find them inside treasure chests (starting with 1.4.0beta) and changed their texture (starting with 1.10.0beta). The Bedrock Edition also enabled turning pages using controller buttons (in 1.6.0beta), selling them to librarians (in 1.11.0beta), and changing the texture again on PlayStation 4 in version 1.90. Legacy Console Edition TU25CU14 and Patch 11.0.1 brought similar changes, adding books and quills with new features. Players can use Book and Quill items to write and sign books, making them useful for writing stories or sharing information within the game world. Issues and restrictions exist regarding these items, such as limitations on book length, page size, and character count, but these can be bypassed using third-party tools or commands. The functionality of signed books remains consistent across different Minecraft editions. Lecterns in Minecraft can be placed on empty space with a book or quill to display the contents of the book, emitting redstone signals based on the displayed page. This feature is exclusive to Bedrock Edition and allows for formatting codes starting with to style text within books. Signing books allows players to leave their name and title, which cannot be edited once signed. The title can contain special characters, but alt codes do not work. Chiseled bookshelves can hold books, and expert-level librarian villagers trade books and quills in specific quantities depending on the game mode. Move the newly crafted item to your inventory and you'll have successfully made a book and quill. Formatting codes do not work on the Book and Quill for both Bedrock Edition and Java Edition. The symbol can be pasted into the book in Bedrock Edition, but it doesn't affect the text display. In Java Edition, formatting codes are not supported at all. Characters added after each character implies that if the last character on a line reaches pixel 114, no room remains for the 1-pixel spacer. As a result, characters with their spacers will be pushed to the next line, leaving only 113 usable pixels per line. This limitation was observed in the Book and Quill GUI, but its applicability to books written in JSON is uncertain since it hasn't been tested.\*\*Book and Quill Crafting\*\*To craft the Book and Quill in Minecraft, open a Crafting Table and follow this recipe: place a Book, Ink Sac, and Feather inside. If you don't have a Crafting Table yet, learn how to make one in Minecraft first. Once crafted, right-click on the Book and Quill to open its GUI.\*\*Written Books\*\*A book written with the Book and Quill is an item used for crafting Written Books. These books can be copied using the same tool, but copies of copies cannot be duplicated again. When copying a written book, the new copies will be labeled as "Copy of Original" or "Copy of Copy", depending on the original's label.\*\*Writing\*\*Players can write single books up to 100 pages long (Java Edition only) or 50 pages long (Bedrock Edition only), with each page having up to 798 characters. The total character limit per book is 79,800 (Java Edition only) or 12,800 (Bedrock Edition only). Each line in the book can have a width of 114 pixels, and most Unicode characters are supported.\*\*Lecterns\*\*One can place a Book and Quill or Written Book on an empty lectern. The lectern then emits a redstone signal depending on the displayed page in the book. When reaching the last page, the lectern's signal strength reaches 15. Formatting codes, exclusive to Bedrock Edition, allow for text styling using character. k changes characters randomly; l creates bold, m strikethrough, n underlined, and o italic. 0-f (hexadecimal) enables colored text, while r resets formatting back to normal. The player can combine multiple codes or continue typing after the end of a line. Each new line will exhibit only the last used code. Signing books in Bedrock Edition allows for any author name; otherwise, it displays the player's name in Java Edition. Once signed and turned into a written book, it cannot be edited again. Special characters can be used in titles, but alt codes do not work, and character cannot be typed. However, on Linux using compose key to produce special characters does work. The title of the book is limited to 16 characters, with no pasting allowed. A workaround for this limitation is renaming the book at an anvil, which costs 1 experience level. Chiseled bookshelf stores a book and quill when used in main hand. Trading in Bedrock Edition involves buying two books and quills for one emerald from expert-level librarian villagers.
