I print these on regular paper and laminate them, so I can write on them with dry erase markers. After taking the anchor chart down, I roll it up and store it for next year. This saves even more time the following year by having these prepped and ready to go. I created these anchor charts for teaching second grade core language standards. We create an anchor chart every Monday, when I introduce the standard, we write directly on the chart or use sticky notes. Some students also come up and write for us this keeps them engaged. Many of the standards require applying the skill to writing. For past tense irregular verbs, I model using it in a sentence by writing on a sentence strip. Students will help create their mini anchor chart during class, and they need a composition notebook to store it throughout the year. They can decorate their own cover, saving ink. Students fill in their mini chart during the lesson and use a table of contents if needed.
