Xavier Léon-Dufour's Dictionary of Biblical Theology is a comprehensive guide for Catholics seeking to deepen their understanding of the Bible. He is known for his *Vocabulaire de théologie biblique*, published in 1962, which remains a reference work for theology students. Léon-Dufour's work on the synoptic gospels and the Gospel of John is significant, and he was involved in doctrinal controversies following Vatican II. He chose to become a priest at the age of 17 and continued his vocation even during World War II, when he became a resitant in the network of southwestern France.
