In the Philippines, there have been 307 recorded aviation accidents since 1619. These incidents have resulted in at least 1619 fatalities. Here are some notable accidents that occurred between 2025 and 2008: * February 6, 2025: A Beechcraft B300 King Air 350 crashed near Metrea Special Aerospace, killing all 4 people on board. * October 23, 2022: An Airbus A330-322 operated by Korean Air made an emergency landing at Mactan-Cebu International Airport after experiencing engine trouble. No one was injured. * July 4, 2021: A Lockheed C-130H Hercules plane belonging to the Philippine Air Force crashed in Sulu province, killing over 50 people on board. * March 29, 2020: An IAI 1124A Westwind II aircraft operated by Lionair Inc. experienced engine failure and crash-landed at Manila-Ninoy Aquino International Airport, injuring 8 people. * September 1, 2019: A Beechcraft B300 King Air 350 operated by Lionair Inc. crashed in Calamba, Laguna province, killing all 9 people on board. * August 16, 2018: A Boeing 737-85C plane operated by Xiamen Airlines made an emergency landing at Manila-Ninoy Aquino International Airport after experiencing engine trouble. No one was injured. * January 10, 2018: A Gulfstream G200 plane operated by Air Taxi PH crashed in Legazpi province, killing all 4 people on board. These are just a few examples of the many aviation accidents that have occurred in the Philippines over the years. This list details 44 aviation accidents in the Philippines that occurred between October 2004 and December 1995. The accidents involved various types of aircraft, including Airbus A320s, Boeing 737s, Fokker F-27s, de Havilland Canada DHC-6 Twin Otters, Cessna 500 Citations, Beechcraft A100 King Airs, and others. Some notable incidents include: * October 2007: An Airbus A320 crashed at Spirit of Manila Airport (MBT), killing all on board. * November 2006: A Yakovlev Yak-40A went down near Manila-Ninoy Aquino International Airport (MNL). * September 2006: A McDonnell Douglas MD-11F FedEx aircraft crashed at Subic Bay International Airport (SFS/RPLB). * March 2004: A Britten-Norman BN-2A-21 Islander crashed in Coron, killing two people. * December 2003: An IRMA/Britten-Norman BN-2A-21 Islander went down near Subic Bay International Airport (SFS). Other incidents included: * Fatalities ranging from zero to 17 people * Various locations, including Manila, Davao City, Cagayan de Oro, and others * Aircraft types include Fokker F-27s, Boeing 737s, Airbus A330s, Let L-410UVP-Es, McDonnell Douglas MD-11Fs, and more. The Philippine military has experienced a series of aviation accidents between 1982 and 1993, resulting in the loss of lives and aircraft. The incidents occurred at various airports across the country, including Manila International Airport, Cebu Airport, and other regional hubs. The listed incidents include: * A Lockheed MC-130E Combat Talon I crash near Tabones Island on July 12, 1980. * A Boeing 727 operated by Philippine Air Lines experienced a non-fatal incident on February 27, 1980. * A China Airlines Boeing 707-309C crashed at Manila International Airport (MNL) on June 26, 1979. * Five people lost their lives in the crash of a United States Navy Lockheed P-3B Orion near Cubi Point NAS on June 26, 1979. * Eight fatalities were reported in the crash of an Acme Plywood & Veneer Company Pilatus Britten-Norman BN-2A-21 Islander near Luzon on September 14, 1978. * A Hukbong Himpapawid ng Pilipinas (Philippine Air Force) Fokker F-27 Friendship crashed in Barrio Santos, Paranaque, on August 17, 1978, killing 15 and injuring 17 people. * A BAC One-Eleven operated by Philippine Air Lines experienced a fatal crash over Simara Island on June 4, 1978. * A Commercial Air Transport Convair VT-29C (CV-240) made an emergency landing at Roxas City Airport (RXS) without incident on October 18, 1977. * Two crew members lost their lives in the crash of a Mandala Airlines Hawker Siddeley HS-748-232 Srs. 2 near Manila International Airport (MNL) on July 17, 1977. * A Philippine Air Lines NAMC YS-11A-301 crashed off Mactan Island on March 31, 1977. * Eight people lost their lives in the crash of a Swiftair Douglas DC-3-217B near Sanga-Sanga on May 23, 1976. * A Philippine Air Lines BAC One-Eleven 527FK crashed at Zamboanga Airport (ZAM) on May 5, 1976, resulting in 13 fatalities. * Four people lost their lives in the crash of a Philippine Aerotransport Britten-Norman BN-2A-21 Islander near Camuigan on January 8, 1976.
