Chase Bank offers online banking services that allow users to monitor their checking accounts, order checks, and view canceled check images. To access deposited checks, users need to know their account number and go through the following steps: - Go to the bank account page and choose the Chase account tile - Select the transactions containing the desired checks or deposit slips - View the front and back of the checks and corresponding deposit slips Users can also view images of both business and personal checks, as well as select "check printing" if needed. To find a check written by the user, they need to know their account number and can filter the results using approximate date, amount, and check number. Chase Bank retains check images online for three years, after which users must order a copy from Chase Bank. Users can also print a record of check deposits or get a copy of deposited checks by selecting "print checks" on the Chase app. Chase Bank Offers Free Checks, But With Conditions The availability of free checks with Chase Bank depends on the checking account selected. The Premier Plus checking account offers this benefit. When ordering new checks, users may need to provide their routing number and bank account number. Check designs are available when the checkbook is empty. Online orders are possible, but paper checks require a 10-14 business day wait period. Certain checks, such as money orders and counter checks, cannot be ordered online or through the mobile app. These services must be requested in-person at a branch. Looking to order custom checks from Chase? Don't forget to have your account number and routing number handy as you'll need them. You can either visit your local Chase branch or use third-party sites like Delux, but be sure to check for security features first. To use a site like Delux: search for "Chase check providers" on Google, sign up with the chosen service, input your Chase account number and routing number, select the desired design and customizations, choose your payment method, provide your address (fees vary depending on the order details), and wait for 7-10 business days to receive your checks. Premium Chase accounts like Premier Plus or Sapphire may qualify you for free checks, but be aware of balance requirements for these perks. If you need checks faster, consider paying an additional fee. Chase also offers alternative payment methods through their mobile app, allowing direct transfers and bill payments via credit cards or Direct Debit. It typically takes around two business days for savings account checks to clear, but this timeframe may be extended if the required details are missing or if it's a government or cashier's check, which can take up to seven days. The processing time varies depending on the type of check being sent. Online ordering through the Chase app is the most convenient option and takes less than two minutes. However, there are alternative methods available, including using the Chase website, third-party sites, or visiting a local branch where you can speak with a customer service representative to request bank checks.
