Crozer Health is a four-hospital health system based in Delaware County, Pennsylvania. The system serves patients in Delaware County, northern Delaware, and western New Jersey. The organization was founded in 1893 with the opening of the Chester Hospital, which grew to meet the needs of its community. Over time, the J. Lewis Crozer Homeopathic Hospital opened nearby, and in 1958, it was renamed Crozer Hospital. In 1963, it merged with Chester Hospital to become the Crozer-Chester Medical Center. The system's history dates back to 1925 when plans for a new hospital were drawn up. The Delaware County Hospital opened in 1927 and later became known as Delaware County Memorial Hospital. In 1970, the Crozer-Chester Medical Center expanded its campus by taking over the grounds of the former Crozer Theological Seminary. Throughout its history, Crozer Health has undergone significant changes. In 1990, it merged with several other hospitals to form Crozer-Keystone Health System, which became the largest provider of healthcare services in Delaware County. Springfield Hospital joined the system in 1960, followed by Sacred Heart Medical Center in 1992 and Taylor Hospital in 1997. Today, Crozer Health is part of Noble Health Alliance, with its headquarters located in Springfield Township, Pennsylvania. In 2013, Healthcare Network established the Noble Health Alliance to promote collaboration among four health systems in Philadelphia and its surrounding areas, aiming to provide more comprehensive care. However, in 2016, the alliance was dissolved due to financial issues. The same year, Crozer-Keystone entered into a deal with Prospect Medical Holdings to be acquired by them. The acquisition was completed in July 2016 after receiving all necessary approvals. In 2020, the system's name was changed from Crozer-Keystone Health System to Crozer Health due to financial difficulties caused by supply chain issues and rising costs during the COVID-19 pandemic. Today, Crozer Health comprises four hospitals and several outpatient centers, including a Level II trauma center, regional burn and cancer centers. Despite its challenges, the health system remains operational, with Taylor Hospital admitting over 7,000 patients annually and Springfield Hospital providing outpatient services after suspending hospital-based operations in January 2022. Crozer-Keystone Health System: A History of Growth and Transformation Crozer Theological Seminary Founded in 1893, Crozer Theological Seminary is a Baptist seminary with its roots in Chester County, Pennsylvania. The seminary has undergone several mergers and acquisitions over the years, including its merger with the Baptist Theological Seminary at New York University in 1921, before becoming an independent institution again. Crozer Health is a healthcare provider with multiple locations in Pennsylvania. It offers various medical services, including cancer treatment and imaging facilities. The organization has several affiliated clinics and hospitals across the state, such as Penn State Cancer Institute, Family Intervention Crisis Services, and Taylor Hospital. Crozer Health also provides diagnostic imaging services through WellSpan Imaging and Quest Diagnostics.
