Rhyzue: My comic Project Stalker has a vertical strip format. It takes me around 7-10 hours to complete one chapter. I'm curious about how long others take. AnnaLandin: For my standard print-format pages, it takes me between 8-10 hours per page. Drawing an entire chapter takes around 270-300 hours. punkarsenic: My chapters are usually 20-30 six-panel pages long and take me a month to complete (technically 15 days, but life gets in the way). I spend about 60-90 hours on each one. spadesart: Chapter 1 of my comic took 3-4 months. I've been working on chapter 2 since July last year. LordZevon: It takes me around 7-8 weeks to complete a chapter, which is equivalent to 210-240 hours. I work in black and white, but the time seems about right for color as well. Houndstooth: My chapter is 35 pages long at A5 size. I typically thumbnail two or three pages each day, and it takes me around 10-14 days to complete a batch of pages (now due to health issues). efdvorsky: For Cosmic Fish, it takes me about 2 days to make a page, which is equivalent to 8 hours per day. One chapter takes an average of 4-5 months. ryoko: I average three pages a week and my chapters are around 30-60+ pages long. It takes me about 3 months to complete one chapter. cleo\_san: Like others, it takes me several months to complete each chapter. Creating a manga typically takes several months to a few years, depending on the individual's pace and workload. For some, producing one page per week is a manageable goal, while others may need more time due to various commitments, such as studies or work. The time it takes to complete a chapter can range from a month or two to around 9 months, with some creators taking up to a year or more to finish a single chapter. Factors like the number of pages per chapter, the level of detail, and the creator's personal circumstances can significantly influence the overall production time. Despite the challenges, many manga creators strive to publish their work regularly, often aiming for weekly updates, and some even compare completing a chapter to giving birth to a "comic baby." The process can be frustrating at times, especially when creators are eager to share their story with readers, but the end result is usually worth the effort. On average, it seems that creating a manga can take anywhere from a few months to several years, with most creators taking around 1-2 years to complete a single volume or story arc.
