Jesus is Baptized

It was a beautiful, warm day as John the Baptist walked along the banks of the Jordan River. In the distance, he saw Jesus and his disciples walking toward him. He wondered why and continued his prayers and preparation for those to be baptized.

As Jesus approached the banks of the river, He told John the Baptist that He was coming into the water and wanted to be baptized. John the Baptist was startled, and mystified but he got a cup of water from the river and poured it over the forehead of Jesus saying the words, "I baptize thee Jesus in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit." Imagine what was going on in the mind of John the Baptist and the disciples. Here is Jesus, the divine one, getting baptized like one of us.

Today is the Feast of the Baptism of Jesus. Like the disciples, all of us have also wondered why Jesus presented himself to be baptized? If you have, your Baptism was one of the greatest gifts you ever had. You are the Church!
