Our Lady of Lourdes

On Wednesday, Feb. 11th, we celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. Bernadette, a French peasant girl, was raised in a pious and Catholic family. Never in her wildest dreams did she ever believe that Mary, the Mother of God would appear to her in the Grotto of Lourdes. When she did and it became public, civil authorities scolded her. However, she never denied seeing the Mother of God.

Pilgrims flocked to the site, and as a result, the Grotto of Lourdes drew thousands of people from all over the world seeking cures and healing.

By appearing in the Grotto of Lourdes, Mary made it a privileged sanctuary where she dispensed her favors and where many sufferers have obtained the cure of their infirmities both spiritual and corporal. Thousands came to the Grotto of Lourdes to implore Mary's maternal intercession.

All of us wish we could visit the Grotto of Lourdes. If you have, then you know the feeling of faith and hope that exists there. But for those who have not . . . just walk into your backyard or go and find an empty space, look up to heaven and talk to Mary.
