God Chooses You to Help

During the Season of Lent, it's a great time to reflect on your life. Father James Keller, founder of the Christophers, wrote, "The mere fact that you are alive, reading these words, no matter your age, the state of your health, or physical condition, means that you have been chosen by God to perform some work that no other person can do. God counts on you to change the world, especially in helping those in need."

There are so many ways to help your neighbor in need. Visit the sick, give care to the aged, help the homeless to be fed, clothed, and washed. Jesus also tells us that when we help the poor, we should do it quietly, intensely, generously, and above all with love. God is counting on you.

Perhaps this true story will help. The proper name of the woman in the story is withheld because of privacy. John and Mary were married with three children. They lived in a run-down neighborhood on the west side of New York City. John was an elevator operator in a large office building, also on the west side. His salary was small, and he depended on tips for favors he did for the office workers.

One night, as he was walking home after leaving the subway, he saw a young, disheveled lady begging for money. As he passed, she said, "I'm hungry and thirsty. Please help me." John then stopped and put his hands in his pocket... he had two dollars and twenty cents. He gave it to her. She kissed his hands and said, "I will always remember you."

About a year later, as John was walking home from the subway, a limousine pulled up beside him. A window rolled down, and a beautiful woman said to John, "You don't remember me. I'm the woman you gave two dollars and twenty cents to when I was begging on the street. After you helped me, I turned my life around and returned to my professional career. Thank you for saving my life... please take this envelope." She then drove away.

John opened the envelope and found a check for \$5,000. He skipped all the way home. God gave John a choice to help, and he followed God's voice. Please help the needy, especially during Lent.


