

Are You Prepared?

Giuseppe was 81 years old and walked with a cane. I knew him as a young boy as he lived near my home. Each morning, come rain or shine, he went to daily Mass. After Mass, he would stop in the bakery and buy a loaf of freshly baked Italian bread. All the kids on the block respected him, and always greeted him with, "Buon Giorno" (Good morning). He would smile and wave his cane at us.

One day as he was walking to church, he tripped and fell. He hit his head on the concrete and severely injured his head and legs. He was taken to the hospital and placed in ICU. He remained there for a few days in a coma, and one morning he suddenly opened his eyes and whispered, "Dear God, I'm ready to come home." Giuseppe died on Easter morning.

I tell you this heartwarming story to remind you that next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. It is the greatest time to reflect on the following truths. One day our material body will die, but if we are faithful, we can live with God along loved ones for all eternity. We should focus on the state of our soul and be sure that we are in a state of grace. We should look forward to the Resurrection of Our Lord from the dead. His death and resurrection gave us new life. Are you prepared to receive Jesus with your heart and soul?

Next week, please remember your loved ones who have passed, and especially the souls in Purgatory who need your prayerful help. They will never forget you when they get to heaven. Be sure that your life is in order so that you can look forward to the Resurrection. Are You Prepared?

At Giuseppe's funeral Mass, the priest after praising this man's faithful life said, "I understand that Giuseppe requested that when he was being buried that his cane be buried with him. Giuseppe wanted to be sure that he could walk to greet Jesus when he gets to heaven." He really wanted to be prepared.

Let's all prepare for Easter. Be sure that we can walk spiritually and happily to Jesus on Easter morning.

Holy Week is important. Are you ready?
