

## STEWARDSHIP CORNER

### *Walk with Jesus*

When Jesus was a little boy, he would hear his mother say, "Come, Jesus, walk with me." They would walk through cobblestone streets of Nazareth and greet their neighbors and friends. Mary would watch each step Jesus took, and when they arrived home, Joseph would be waiting for them. When Jesus saw Joseph, He would run into his arms and hug him.

Later in life, Jesus also walked with His disciples to pray, eat and preach to the crowds. Jesus loved to walk, but how sad to think that the last walk Jesus took was on the road to Calvary where He died on the cross. This coming week is Holy Week. It is an invitation to all of us to walk with Jesus as He instituted the Eucharist and ordained his first priests on Holy Thursday. On Good Friday, He would share His Passion and Death. Finally, at the Easter Vigil, we will rejoice and walk with Jesus as we witness His resurrection from the dead.

It all begins today, Palm Sunday, as we celebrate the triumphant entry of Jesus into the city of Jerusalem. A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road while others cut branches of palms and strewed them on the ground as Jesus passed by. But little did they know the palms would turn into a crown of thorns and would soon be placed on Jesus' head as they led Him to his death.

So, as you leave the church today with your palm in hand, remember, they will become a crown of thorns. "Will you be there to walk with Jesus during His Passion, Death and Resurrection?" Jesus is inviting all of us to "Come and Walk with Him" during this week. If you do, you will discover the true meaning of Easter, an invitation to eternal life if you are a faithful follower.

If you walk with Jesus, you will never walk alone. Will you walk?
