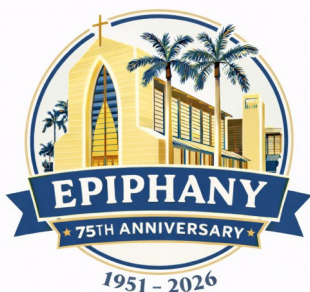

Pilgrimage of Hope

Holy Mother, the Church, designated the year 2025 as the "Pilgrimage of Hope".
