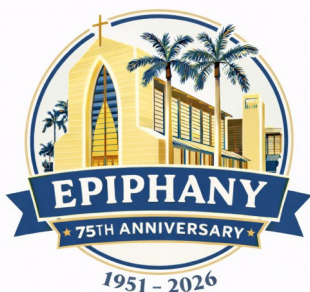

I read this true story in a Catholic magazine . . . Many years ago, when Johnny was a young boy of 14, his grandfather wanted to go to the cemetery to visit Grandma who had died a few years before. They were very close and loved each other dearly. Johnny's mother was worried that her father might get lost and asked Johnny to go with him. She feared that he would get disoriented because he was 86 years old.

Johnny and his grandfather got onto a subway near their home in Brooklyn and went to Canal Street in New York city. When they exited the station, his grandfather marched Johnny down one street and avenue after the other, through the park until they came to St. John's cemetery.

He dragged me through streets, avenues and a million gravesites before he found Grandma. He didn't need me." Johnny's mother laughed and kissed him.

As Johnny grew up, he learned a great lesson from his grandfather . . . "True Love" is a beautiful gift. The love his Grandpa had for his wife didn't end with her death and continued on knowing that one day when he dies, he will be with her in heaven, all together they will love God for all eternity.
