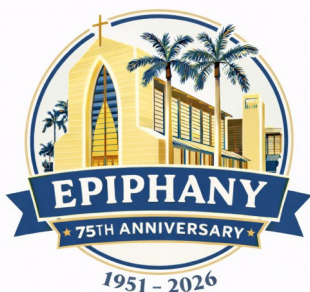

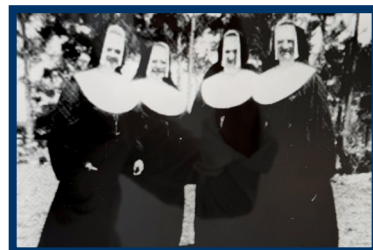

Are you Lonely?

One morning as I was taking a walk, I noticed an elderly lady walking her dog. As I passed by, I said, "Good morning. I hope you are having a nice day." She looked stunned and said to me, "You are the first person who spoke to me this week." We chatted for a while, and as I walked away it hit me, loneliness is a terrible hardship. St. Mother Theresa wrote that the worse poverty one can have is loneliness because it makes you feel unwanted and unloved.

There are thousands of people in the world who are lonely. They come of all ages, sizes and shapes, and because they are alone, they are unhappy. As the years go by, they feel unwanted, and death is their only future. How can the lonely be helped? There is only one answer, prayer and good work, and above all hope.

Prayer is simply talking to God each day, as well as to the Blessed Mother. By starting your day with prayer or daily Mass, you will find yourself a little happier. When you pray, remember your loved ones and the happy times you spent together. God loves you and will never leave you.

Ask God to walk with you, and the Blessed Mother to guide you, and you will never feel alone.

May God console and bless the lonely.
