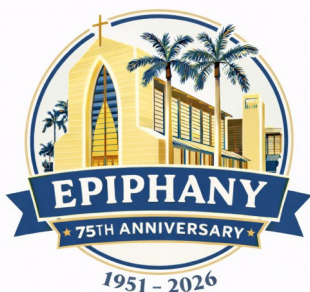

Sacred Heart of Jesus

The month of June is devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. On Friday, we celebrate this feast, and on Sunday we celebrate the feast of His Body and Blood.

God loved us so much that when He saw man on earth floundering, unhappy and alone, He decided to come to earth. What did He do? He entered the body of Mary miraculously as a baby. He wanted to be like man and take on human nature. He was raised by Joseph and Mary. He grew up in their home like any other baby. He was playful, obedient and loving.

When Jesus grew up, He left them to fulfill His mission on earth. But He never left Joseph and Mary far from His Sacred Heart. He then Chose twelve Apostles to follow Him.
