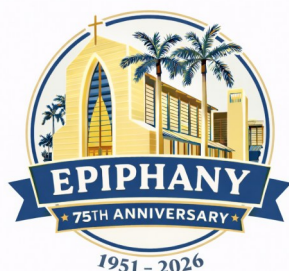

Walk and Hold the Hand of Jesus

When Jesus was a little boy growing up, He often went for a walk with His mother, Mary. She always held His hand and showed Him the different birds, the beautiful flowers, and the wonderful marvels of nature. When they were through with their walk, they would visit with Joseph, who would teach Jesus about the craft of carpentry. Jesus treasured His walk.

Each of us would like to walk and hold Jesus' hand every day of our lives. The only way that is possible is that you pray every day and ask Jesus to guide you. Prayer ties you to Jesus in a very special way. Let's talk a little about prayer.

So many people think they must pray from a prayer book or recite the Our Father or Hail Mary to be prayerful. But the best way to pray is simply by talking to God, like you would to your mother or father. Speak from your heart. Tell God what is on your mind. You don't have to persuade God to listen. If you pray this way, you will find it easy to walk with Jesus and hold His hand every day of your lives. So, begin and end your day with God. God does answer your prayers, and His answers would be the following . . . "No, because that is not helpful for you" . . . Yes, but you will have to wait" . . . Yes, but not what you expect" . . . "Yes, I thought you would never ask". God will always answer your prayers. His answers are always for your very best interest.

So, if you want to walk with Jesus and hold his hand every day of your lives, pray every day and He will hold your hand during your lifetime. He will bring you peace and love, and you will never feel alone.

So, if you walk with Jesus and hold his hand through daily prayer, you will run into his arms in heaven and be happy for all eternity.
