Hold God's Hand

One day as I was walking my dog as a little boy, I noticed an old lady crying. I said to her, "Can I help you?" She looked at me, and whispered, "I'm very sick, and I'm afraid I'm going to die." I was only ten years old, and I didn't know what to say. Then I said, "There's a church down the block, why not talk to God?" She looked at me with surprise and walked to the church down the block.

When I got home, I told my mother what happened. I thought she would be angry with me because she told me not to speak to strangers. She looked at me and said, "You did very well – God will help her." Suffering is a hard burden to bear. Why does God allow suffering? There is no one who suffered more than Jesus to save us for all eternity. Suffering is a part of living.

All of us in one way or another will suffer during our lifetime. If you learn to accept your suffering not as a punishment, but as a part of living, and ask God to walk with you, you can live with pain. However, sometimes when people suffer, they often react in anger. Anger needs to run its course; it should not be repressed. It can, however, be used to supply positive energy to engage your thoughts to eternal life and to God.

Go to God when you suffer. Mother Theresa of Calcutta said that Jesus comes to us in "disturbing disguises" referring to the sick and dying people she ministers to on the streets of India. She trained her sisters to see the face of God in everyone's suffering.

Whenever suffering comes into your life – mental, physical – no matter how bad you feel – go to God. Kneel before his crucifix and ask Him to help you bear your suffering and to offer it up for all your sins. St. Francis de Sales wrote, "Do not fear what may happen tomorrow. The same loving Father who cares for you today will care for you tomorrow and every day. Either He will shield you from suffering, or he will give you unflinching strength to bear it."

Suffering is a part of life – "Hold God's Hand".
