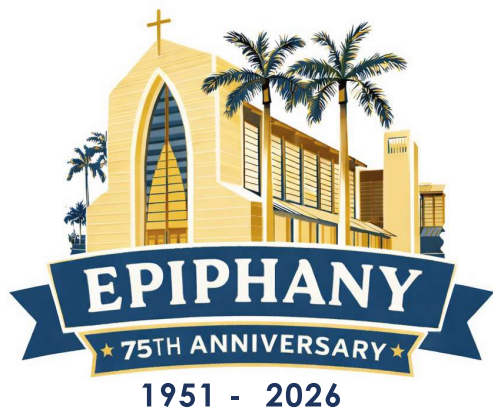

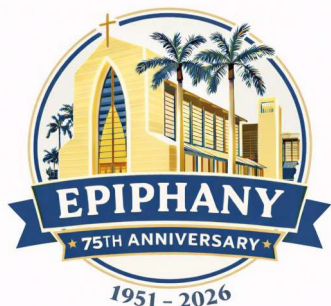

Our Lady of Sorrows

Recently I visited a dear friend who was dying in the hospital. When I got to the ICU, I met his wife and three sons. John was a loving father, thoughtful, faithful and devoted to God. But now his family was in deep sadness. They were crying as they spoke to me, and their sorrow was very evident. Then that final moment came, John died, and the family fell apart. As I drove home, it was clearer to me that our lives were filled with moments of joy, and moments of sadness. It's so hard to accept those moments of sorrow.

So, on Tuesday, Sept. 15th, take a moment and talk to Mary, and she will bring you great comfort and joy.
