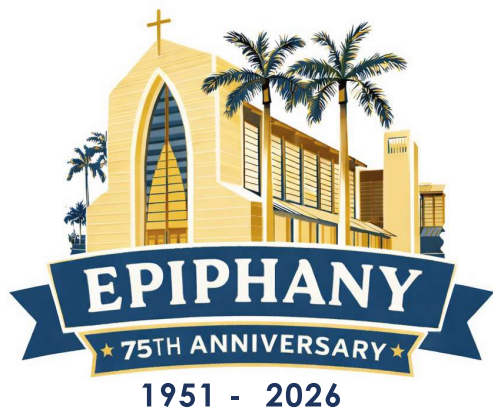

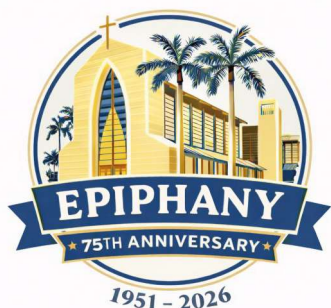

STEWARDSHIP CORNER

O.C.I.A. *The Faith Sharer*

In the early church, converts to Christianity were first known as "Catechumens", as they received instructions on the fundamentals of Christianity. When that instruction period ended, they would choose whether to be baptized or not. When the newly baptized were accepted into the church, it was their responsibility to share their faith with other catechumens.

How many of us have ever shared our faith with others? How many of us really understand the truths of our faith? How many of us really feel confident explaining our faith, and answering questions non-Catholics may have?

So, it is not surprising that the church initiated the O.C.I.A. "The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults" which is an updated version of the way the first catechumens became followers of Jesus Christ. The whole process of the O.C.I.A. is designated to help one grow spiritually, and to better love God as He really is. It can be the start of many people a new, more loving and fulfilling life.

Remember the Letters O.C.I.A. Who is it for? It is for those who wish to be baptized, for those of other denominations who wish to be converted, and for those Catholics who for whatever reason never received Holy Communion and Confirmation. But it is also for Catholics who want to understand their faith better, and to be able to share their faith with others.

Since 1984, hundreds of men and women have attended the O.C.I.A. program. They are now faithful Catholics, sharing their faith. As a result, our church has been blessed with conversions, newly baptized Catholics, Catholic marriages and believe me happy homes.

The O.C.I.A. is a journey of truth, peace and love. Please pray for those who are entering the O.C.I.A.
