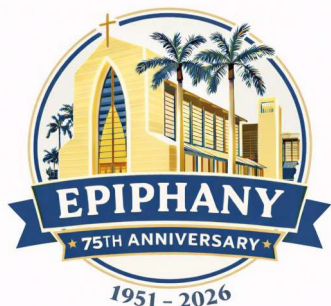

Do you Pray?

"Mommy, when it's my birthday, may I have a puppy?" Mom stared at Billy. "Oh, I don't know. When you say your prayers at night, ask God for the puppy." . . . "But suppose God doesn't like puppies?" . . . "God loves every living creature He created."

From that day on, Billy prayed every night to God for a puppy.

His eighth birthday came, and when he woke up, he rushed downstairs to see his gifts. He saw a few boxes, but no puppy. Billy said to himself, "God doesn't like puppies." Then out of the corner of his eye, he saw a little puppy in the corner of the room. He ran over and yelled, "Mommy, Daddy, I have a little puppy. I will call him Trixie. He was so often seen in prayer that he was said to have made his decision on his knees. It was the power and light in prayer that helped Pope John Paul II bring hope to so many.

May I leave you with the following thought . . . Just pray and do your best, and God will do the rest, and remember the words of Blessed John Paul II "Be Not Afraid".

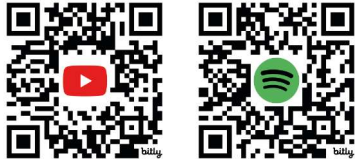
