Mentee Requirements

- Mentee coaches are motivated individuals ready to learn and develop. To participate, mentees must:
- Hold a Provincial membership and an EC Sport Licence (in good standing)
- Complete Make Ethical Decisions + Rule of Two modules
- Hold Registered or Licensed Coach Status
- Meet rider level prerequisites:
 - English: LTR 6 (Instructor) or LTR 8 (Competition Coach)
 - Western: LTR 4; Competition Coach requires Intermediate Rider Basic Training
- Be committed to building a strong mentor relationship

Mentorship Commitment

- Minimum one hour per week of mentorship
- Help set goals, strategies, and timelines
- Monthly check-ins and progress guidance
- Accessible via phone/email; Zoom or in-person when possible
