The Early Childhood Care and Education Authority (ECCEA) is responsible for promoting and providing quality preschool education in Mauritius, operating under the Ministry of Education. Formerly known as the Pre-School Trust Fund, ECCEA came into operation in June 2008. The authority aims to provide equal access to quality pre-schooling for all children, including those at risk or with disabilities. Key functions include implementing government policies on early childhood care and education, setting norms and standards for educational institutions, registering and supervising educational institutions, advising on training programs for educators, administering grants, and preventing violence against young children. ECCEA also has the power to raise funds and secure support for its activities. In addition to its regular functions, ECCEA organizes events such as Universal Children's Day and Kiddy Science Fairs, which promote child-centered approaches and play-based learning in collaboration with other organizations like the Rajiv Gandhi Science Centre. The National Curriculum Framework for Pre-Primary Education (3-5 years) has been implemented, outlining a developmental learner profile and themed transit guidelines. The Grant-in-Aid Scheme for Free Pre-primary Education provides support to private pre-primary schools. A provisional list of private pre-primary schools participating in the grant scheme is available. Pedagogical resources, including school holiday services forms and ECCEA Youtube registration for educators, are also accessible. The Early Childhood Care and Education Authority (ECCEA) collaborates with the Economic Development Board to establish a database for private pre-primary school educators. Registration for educators can be completed by clicking on the provided link. Key aspects of pre-primary education include: - Communication Language and Literacy (CLL) - Mathematical and Logical Thinking (MLT) - Body and Environmental Awareness (BEA) - Expressive, Creative, and Aesthetic Development (ECAD) Additionally, resources for parents and teachers are available, covering topics such as health physical development, creative ideas, storytelling, and Covid-19 information.
