## Game on expo 2025

To drive community growth, we foster collaboration, build connections, and contribute to a thriving city core that fosters positive experiences and pride in Downtown. A mobile game developed by three young Bahraini developers is showcased at the Bahrain Pavilion at Expo 2025 in Osaka, offering visitors an interactive introduction to the kingdom's landmarks and economic potential. The Game On Expo, a celebration of gaming, esports, and anime, takes place from August 5-7 at the Phoenix Convention Center. This year's event features video game and esports tournaments, a marketplace with vendors, cosplay competition, scavenger hunt, and more. Notable attractions include retro gaming on classic systems like Atari and SEGA Dreamcast, panels on topics like anime, cosplay, and card-collecting games, and autograph sessions with popular voice actors. We want the casuals to come out and have fun in a family-friendly environment where everyone feels welcome," says Lester. Game On Expo 2022 will bring together well-known voice actors from anime shows and video games, including a reunion with Cloud Strife and Sephiroth from Final Fantasy VII. The convention will celebrate 30 years of the original Mortal Kombat game with appearances by Daniel Pesina, who played Johnny Cage, Scorpion, and Sub-Zero, and Ho-Sung Pak, who played Liu Kang and Shang Tsung. Other guests include Roger Craig Smith, Colleen O'Shaughnessey, Jazz Fenton, Sora Takenouchi, Cherami Leigh, David Kaye, Kira Buckland, Kellen Goff, and Samantha Kelly. Many attendees will dress up in costume, and a cosplay competition on Saturday evening will feature categories for novice, journeyman, master, and youth. Local Resident Evil, Halo, and Transformers cosplay groups will also be present. Game On Expo 2022 will have gaming tournaments with players of various skill levels, including professional gamers such as Aaron "Jaws" Homoki. The tournaments will feature retro games like Classic Tetris, Dr. Mario, and Ms. Pac-Man, as well as current games like Tekken 7 and Super Smash Bros. Ultimate. Lester sees gaming as an experience for people, similar to music. He appreciates how gamers come up with unique techniques when playing old-school games. Over 200 vendors will sell video and anime-themed products, including games and artwork, while local organizations share information about their activities. Meanwhile, several arcade bars across metro Phoenix have agreed to lend their pinball and arcade games to the event. The convention is heavily influenced by its attendees, including businesses, collectors, cosplayers, and gamers. According to Lester, the founder of Game On Expo, it's a community-driven event that has grown significantly since its inception in 2015. With thousands of people attending every year, the event now includes activities such as anime fandom, esports, concerts, and cosplay. Game On Expo Will Take Place from August 5-7 The convention will be held at the South Building of the Phoenix Convention Center. Admission costs between \$30-\$35 for a one-day pass, with discounts available for children under 10 or those purchasing a full-weekend pass. Get ready for a gaming extravaganza! And, as a special treat, skateboarding legend Tony Hawk will make his first-ever con appearance at Game On Expo! Game On Expo 2025 promises to be an exciting event, with a star-studded lineup of special guests that includes voice actors, YouTube creators, professional cosplayers, and gaming industry icons. Among the notable attendees is Tony Hawk, who will make his first-ever con appearance. The cosplay contest will be held on Saturday at 4-6:30 p.m. in panel room 127ABC, with prizes awarded to the best costumes. Game On Expo 2025 will also feature outdoor performances by geeky musicians and bands along Third Street each day of the event. The schedule includes live drum covers of retro game music by Jason Heine on Friday at 4:30 p.m., an interactive video game concert by Extra Lives at 6 p.m., and a J-pop performance by Shihori at 7:30 p.m. Get ready for a gaming and anime extravaganza at the 2025 Game On Expo! The three-day event takes place from April 4 to 6 at the Phoenix Convention Center. Game On Expo 2025 Ticket Information and Event Details Game On Expo, the biggest gaming occasion in Arizona, is now open to all ages. Tickets are available at gameonexpo.com, with single-day general admission passes starting at \$37 (plus fees) for April 4 or 6, and \$47.50 (plus fees) for April 5. A weekend general admission pass is \$68 (plus fees), while children under 2 can attend for free with a paid adult. The event also features VIP full-event passes for \$178 (plus fees), offering priority access to security, guest autograph lines, and early entry into the vendor hall. The Game On Expo will showcase great guests from anime and computer games, as well as esports game competitions, retro gaming competitions, arcade competitions, tabletop/CCG's competitions, and a cosplay contest. The event aims to bring the G.A.M.E. (Gaming, Anime, Music, Esports) to Arizona, with a mission to celebrate 10 years of hosting the convention. The expo will also support a good cause, as \$1 from each pass sold will be donated to The Skatepark Project, a California-based nonprofit founded by Hawk that provides public grants to fund skateparks in low-income communities across the U.S. Game On Expo is an annual video game, anime, and tabletop gaming convention held at the Phoenix Convention Center in Arizona, US. It has been active since August 2015 and has grown significantly every year. The event features a large vendor hall, arcade area, free-play games, tournaments, cosplay contests, panels, and special guests. In 2022, it had over 12,000 attendees, making it the largest gaming convention in Arizona. The expo also hosts the Retro World Championships, a competition organized by industry legends, including the original Nintendo World Championships champion Thor Aackerlund. The event is sponsored by RetroUSB, which provides a limited edition Game On Expo edition cart as the main prize. Game On Expo has expanded its offerings over the years, introducing live music, video game voice actors, and new attractions like Maid Cafes and Pachinko rooms. In 2019, it saw a 30% increase in attendance and featured an original Pokémon guest reunion. The event was cancelled in 2020 due to the COVID pandemic but returned in 2022 with a 50% growth in attendance. In 2022, Game On Expo also expanded its anime and tabletop gaming content and hosted events like laser tag and the Classic Tetris World Championship qualifiers. The expo has become a hub for gamers, anime fans, and collectors, offering something for everyone. The Game On Expo (also known as Expo) is an annual gaming convention that has been held since 2015. The event features various activities such as esports tournaments, cosplay contests, and musical performances. Over the years, the expo has had several notable guests, including video actors from popular games like Halo and The Last of Us, as well as professional gamers and streamers. In 2023, Expo introduced a new gaming tournament called Gamonathon, which featured retro games and a prize package that included next-generation consoles. The event also announced a change in venue to the North Building of the Phoenix Convention Center, allowing for larger crowds.
