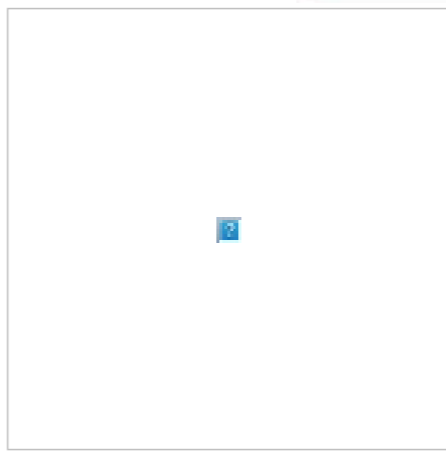

For this activity, give your child one of the pages and have them follow the pattern to complete it. They can color in the pictures and circle the correct picture that completes the pattern. Children participate in various pattern-based activities on this preschool worksheet set. The first activity involves reading patterns with shapes and drawing the correct ones to complete them. This is followed by number patterns where children apply rules such as +2, -2, or +5 to complete each row according to its specific rule. The sixth activity also deals with number patterns but introduces varying rules across each row. Attributes like shape, size, direction, and color are analyzed in the seventh task by circling the attribute that changes for each pattern. The eighth activity requires children to follow a pattern and circle the correct letter pattern below it. Finally, they assess sequences of lines by answering 'yes' if it's a pattern or 'no' if it isn't.
