When upgrading RouterOS to v7 major release, it's recommended to follow the Upgrade manual for detailed steps. For those running version 6 or older, we suggest updating to the latest stable or long-term release in v6 first. Some features may require extra attention during the upgrade process. The new RouterOSv7 configuration is rewritten in a script-like format. Rules can now use "if...then" syntax to set parameters or apply actions based on conditions. Multiple rules without action are stacked and executed like a firewall, where the order of "set" parameters matters for easier understanding. PIM-SM multicast routing configuration is no longer preserved after upgrading to RouterOSv7. Instead, it's available under /routing/pimsm, and an additional "multicast" package isn't required anymore. The User Manager in RouterOSv7 has been redesigned with a new implementation that integrates into the WinBox and console interfaces. However, direct migration from older versions is not possible; instead, you can migrate the database using /user-manager/database/migrate-legacy-db before starting fresh configuration. Key features of RouterOSv7 include: * A New Kernel for performance changes * A completely new NTP client and server implementation * Merged individual packages into bundles with few extra packages remaining * Support for Let's Encrypt certificate generation, REST API, UEFI boot mode, IPv6 NAT, Layer 3 hardware acceleration on CRS3xx devices, MBIM driver support, MLAG on CRS3xx devices, VRRP grouping and connection tracking data synchronization between nodes, Virtual eXtensible Local Area Network (VXLAN), L2TPv3, OpenVPN UDP transport protocol, WireGuard, hardware offloaded VLAN filtering on RTL8367 and MT7621 switches, ZeroTier support on ARM and ARM64 devices, and hardware offloaded VLAN filtering on RTL8367 and MT7621 switches.
