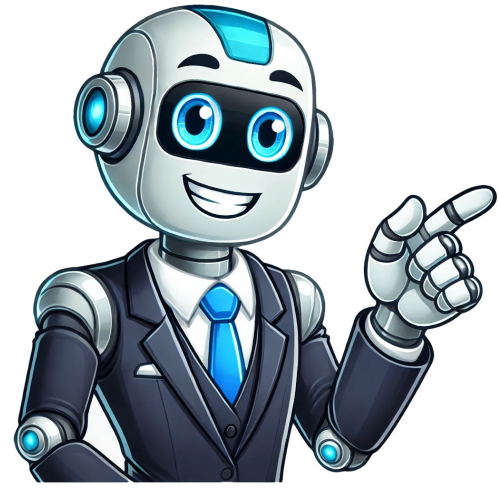

It all boils down to the origins of the holiday. The UK celebrates "Mothering Sunday" on the fourth Sunday of Lent, tracing back to the Middle Ages. In contrast, our American Mother's Day has a more recent history, officially declared a U.S. holiday in 1914 by Anna Jarvis, the "mother" of Mother's Day.Anna Jarvis's mother, Anne Jarvis, had 13 children, but only four reached adulthood due to high infant and child mortality rates in 19th-century Appalachia. This experience motivated Anne to host Mothers' Day Work Clubs to educate families on proper precautions to prevent disease spread. After her passing, Anna organized the first Mother's Day-related function in their hometown of Grafton, West Virginia.Anna's hard work paid off when President Woodrow Wilson declared Mother's Day a national holiday in 1914. However, Anna soon grew disenchanted with the commercialization that followed and later regretted starting the holiday.To celebrate this special day, why not bake her a cake? You can also do something together based on her favorite hobbies or make her a DIY gift!Mother's Day is a special occasion to appreciate and celebrate the love and care that mothers provide. It's not just about treating them to dinner at a restaurant, but also about spending quality time with them and showing your appreciation in meaningful ways. The origins of Mother's Day are attributed to several individuals, with Julia Ward Howe and Anna Jarvis being two key figures in its establishment in the United States. The first Mother's Day function took place on May 10, 1908, in Grafton, West Virginia.Annas efforts eventually caught the attention of President Woodrow Wilson's cabinet, and it was decided that Mother's Day would be a national holiday, taking place on the second Sunday in May every year.The modern concept of Mother's Day has strayed far from its original intent, bearing little resemblance to Anna Jarvis' initial vision or her mother's charitable endeavors. The traditional gifts of flowers and greeting cards were not part of the plan, with Anna even referring to manufacturers of these products as "schemers" and "profiteers." In fact, she allegedly expressed regret over starting Mother's Day altogether. Although the true origins of the holiday are unclear, with Julia Ward Howe having promoted a "Mothers' Peace Day" in 1872 as part of her anti-war efforts, the core idea of dedicating a day to honor one's mother remains profound. Despite the commercialization that surrounds it, the heart of the holiday retains its beauty and significance, serving as a testament to the enduring importance of acknowledging the woman who gave you life.
