You can set a preferred quote style for quick fixes and formatting in VS Code (Visual Studio Code). Here's how:1. Navigate to the Settings page of VS Code: File > Preferences > Settings (hotkeys: Ctrl + ,).2. Search for "single quote" and head to the "Javascript > Preferences: Quote Style" section, selecting your preferred quote style ("single" or "double"). Check the screenshot for clarification.3. Repeat this process in the "TypeScript > Preference: Quote Style" section.4. If you're using Prettier, check/uncheck the checkboxes in the "Prettier: jsx Single Quote" and "Prettier: Single Quote" sections. You can auto-format code with these shortcuts: Option + Shift + F (Mac) or Alt + Shift + F (Windows). For example, "import axios from 'axios'" will replace double quotes with single quotes. If you're new to VS Code, check out our article on formatting code in VS Code. To switch from double quotes to single quotes in VS Code, follow these steps:4. Open the Command Palette by pressing Ctrl + Shift + P (or Command + Shift + P on macOS).Type user settings and select Preferences: Open User Settings.Now you can set your preferred quote style in your settings.json file by adding the following properties:"javascript.preferences.quoteStyle": "single", "typescript.preferences.quoteStyle": "single".If you want to use double quotes, replace "single" with "double".When using Prettier, enable the Prettier: Single Quote setting. If you manage Prettier settings through your package.json file, add these lines: "prettier": { "singleQuote": true, "jsxSingleQuote": true }. If using a .editorconfig file, change the quote_type to single or double instead. Make sure VS Code is restarted after changes. For default attribute values in completion, go to File > Preferences > Settings and search for 'Attribute Default Value'. Then, select 'singlequotes' from the dropdown.
