European powers established coffee plantations in their colonies, and types of coffee were often named after their origin ports. In Brazil and the Caribbean, most cultivation relied on slave labor, while in Java, coffee was used as a form of taxation payment. Coffee became almost as crucial as tea, but its consumption patterns differed between Britain and the USA. In the 19th century, prices dropped due to improvements in transportation, making coffee more accessible to industrial workers who needed its energizing effects to work during long hours at night. If you've got a nice jacket, wear that with a skirt or trousers. Arrive in plenty of time. They hate people who are late. So make sure you know exactly where you have to get to. One other useful piece of advice my manager told me before I had the interview for this job - is to smile. Even if you feel terrified. It makes people respond better to you.
