Sex guide vietnam

Massage parlors offer better deals - a one-hour massage finishing with a hand job costs around 700k including tip. A blow job in a hot toc in Saigon is surprisingly affordable at 400k, while street hookers usually charge between 700-1,000k for the night. If you mix paid sex with free sex from dating site girls, your daily expenses would be about 500k or 20 USD per day. Add this to other daily costs like food (20 USD), transport (7 USD), and nightlife (15 USD) and you get a total of 112 USD per day, or about 1,600 USD for two weeks. Note: This calculation doesn't include one-time expenses like flights, travel health insurance, and domestic trips.
