If you find any inaccuracies in our FAQs, please let us know using our contact form. Isofix car seats often have universal approval for securement with seat belts, as well as car-specific approval. This allows the seat to be secured with seat belts; however, not all Isofix car seats can be secured this way. Consult the manual of your specific car seat for details. When placing a child in a car seat, the safest place is usually the middle of the back seat, provided there is a full 3-point seatbelt available. If only a lap belt is present, it's safer to use the back window seat. This rule may vary based on individual cars and models. There are no international guidelines for using car seats in airplanes. The suitability of your car seat for air travel depends on the model and the airline's policies. It's essential to contact the airline ahead of time to verify this information. Isofix car seats can be either universal or non-universal. A non-universal Isofix car seat can only be used with specific car models, which are listed in the seat itself. On the other hand, a universal Isofix car seat can only be used in cars equipped with Isofix and a Top Tether attachment point. Remember not to let your child sit in a car seat for more than 1.5 to 2 hours a day. Some modern strollers allow attaching the car seat on top for quicker transportation, but still adhere to this time limit. Isofix is an internationally standardized system for mounting car seats in cars. It involves using Isofix mounting brackets located between the backrest and the seat of the back seat. The hooks on the Isofix car seat can be easily attached to these brackets. [Page 25] Installation Instructions: 1.
