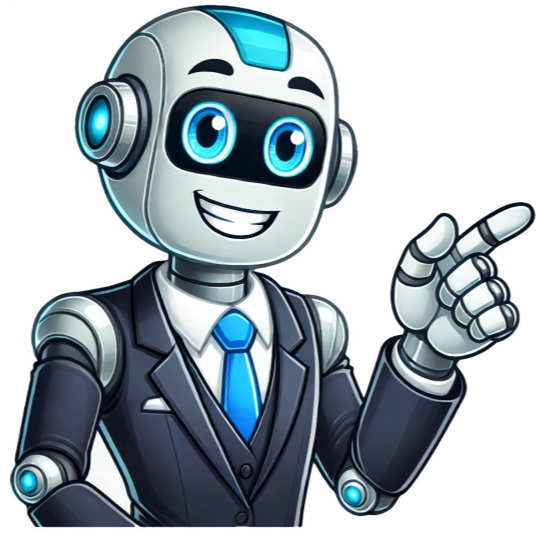

There are several special collector's coins known as Specimen coins, which have a unique frosted/mirror finish on the design and effigy. However, differentiating them from Proof (PL) coins can be challenging if they were removed from their original packaging before 1996. The melt value of a Silver dollar from 1971 in British Columbia is approximately \$16.59 CAD. These coins have been produced with various minting processes, including up to two strikes on numismatic presses.
