## **Gear one pa2400 user manual**

I'm experiencing an issue with my Gear One 2400 powered mixer. When I shut it off, the speakers make a loud "pop" sound, even though I've turned down the volume/gain. I was wondering if unplugging the speakers before shutting off would be safe and has anyone else encountered this problem with this model or other mixers? As someone new to setting up sound, I'm learning through trial and error. Additionally, I'm having trouble getting my VST instruments to come out of my computer via the Apogee Duet 2 and into the Vintech preamp without picking up other tracks. I think I need a high-to-low impedance adapter coming out of the duet, but I'd appreciate any guidance on how to achieve this setup. Specifically, I want to isolate the solo'd VST instrument and record it with minimal processing through the Vintech to beef up the sound. The PA2400 mixer stands out with its dual seven-band graphics, one for each amp. This unique feature allows you to tailor the EQ settings specifically for your monitors and mains, ensuring optimal performance and minimizing feedback issues. The mixer boasts 24-bit FX processing with 100 preset options, including various effects like reverb, delay, echo, chorus, flanger, and rotary, all with adjustable parameters. Accessing a preset is straightforward - simply turn the knob until the number appears on the display, then press to select. The PA2400 offers separate FX level controls for mains and monitors, as well as a footswitch input for remote FX activation or deactivation. Its ergonomic design features well-placed handles on each end, making it easy to transport without straining your back. The tilt-back panel allows the control panel to be at a comfortable angle when placed on a table. The Gear One MV1000 dynamic microphone is built to withstand rugged use, delivering crisp and clear sound with its cardioid polar pattern for improved isolation and reduced feedback. The package includes a carrying pouch, stand adapter, and one-year warranty for added peace of mind.
