Personal data that we process

Stichting Gospel Transformation processes your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide this data to us yourself.

We may process the following personal data:

- First and last name
- Bank account number
- Gender
- Date of birth
- Address details
- Phone number
- Email address

Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years of age. Unless they have permission from parents or guardians. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore recommend that parents be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. If you are convinced that we have collected personal data about a minor without that permission, please contact us via info@gospel-transformation.org, and we will delete this information.

Why we process your personal data

We process your personal data

- To process payments or donations
- To send newsletters and other digital or on-paper communication
- To contact you if necessary to deliver our services

Automated decision-making

Stichting Gospel Transformation does not use techniques that lead to automated decision-making.

How long we store personal data

We retain your personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes for which it was collected. In general, we store personal data for up to two years after your last contact with us. Exceptions include financial data, which we retain for the legally required period under Dutch tax law.

Sharing personal data with third parties

We use external service providers to process some of your personal data. Specifically, we use Mailchimp (www.mailchimp.com) to manage our contacts. This includes your name, email address, address, phone number and information about your engagement with our foundation (e.g. whether you are a donor and your communication preferences). Mailchimp complies with applicable data protection laws, including the GDPR, and has appropriate safeguards in place.

For book keeping purposes, we use Informer (<https://www.informer.eu>) to process donations and payments. This includes your name, email address, address, phone number and details about your donations/purchases. Informer complies with applicable data protection laws, including the GDPR, and has appropriate safeguards in place.

Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Stichting Gospel Transformation does not use cookies or similar techniques.

View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent for data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Stichting Gospel Transformation and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data that we have about you in a computer file to you or another organization named by you.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to info@gospel-transformation.org.

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your ID with the request. In this copy, black out your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen

Service Number (BSN). This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as soon as possible, but within four weeks.
