

EMERGENCY BATTERY BACK-UP SYSTEM

Emergency Battery Back-Up System

Once installed your emergency battery back-up system requires little to no maintenance from onsite personnel.

Your emergency battery back-up system is designed to work automatically to provide power to your critical security alarm system during a prolonged power outage.

The system works by monitoring the incoming A/C power to the alarm control panel. When it senses power loss, it works in parallel with the system battery to provide the required D/C power to the alarm system. By using the marine battery, the new battery back-up system is able to power the alarm system for days as opposed to hours by using the alarm system battery only.

Possible maintenance by onsite personnel:

- Battery Replacement. From time to time you may be asked to replace the marine battery.
 - 1. Unlatch the quick connect battery terminal connectors and lift up to remove from battery. ***Note: Do not allow battery terminal connectors to touch as it will short the system and cause irreparable damage.
 - 2. Release the strap holding the battery to the tray.
 - 3. Remove battery from tray and replace with similar battery from shelf.
 - 4. Replace strap holding battery to tray.
 - 5. Slide the blue quick connect battery terminal connector over the negative (-) terminal and close quick connect terminal connector to latch in place. Slide the red quick connect battery terminal connector over the positive (+) terminal and close quick connect terminal connector to latch in place.
