WM TO CONTINUE PARTNERSHIP IN THE CITY OF ZACHARY; INTRODUCE NEW RECYCLING CARTS

Transition to new recycling carts begins on October 1.

BATON ROUGE – September 8, 2025 – WM announced today it will continue waste collection and recycling service in the City of Zachary and will transition residential recycling customers to 96-gallon carts beginning in October. The larger recycling carts will replace the 18-gallon bins currently collected for recycling. This will mark the largest capacity cart for residential recycling service in the City of Zachary to date.

Beginning October 6, residents who currently participate in recycling will receive one (1) 96-gallon recycling cart per household. To continue participating in the City's recycling program, residents must use the new 96-gallon cart.

All regular garbage collection services in the City of Zachary will remain the same. Currently, there is no change to the recycling service day schedule.
