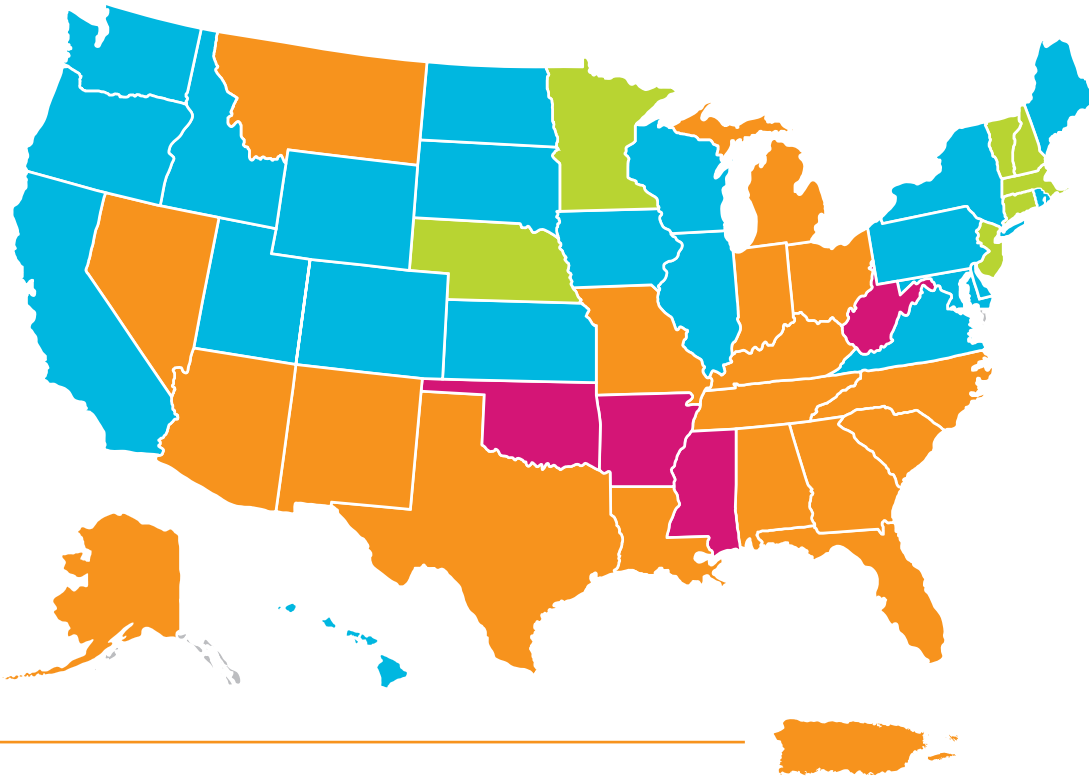


The values in the keys [ ] represent the position of Puerto Rico in comparison with the 50 states and the District of Columbia. The number 1 position in the data denotes the worst condition recorded in each indicator. The State Index portrays the conditions of children and young people in the archipelago through 27 indicators in five fundamental dimensions: economy, family, education, health and safety.

# Ratings of compared jurisdictions



**Puerto Rico** ranks **21** in relation to the other 51 U.S. jurisdictions assessed in this Index, giving Puerto Rico a D rating.
