WITH LOVE

A RECENT LOVE LETTER SENT TO CHILD CRISIS ARIZONA



My story is one of resilience, growth, and the incredible impact of finding a supportive community through Child Crisis Arizona's Family Education classes.

I am separated from my soon-to-be ex-husband, who was abusive. Despite counseling, he placed all the blame for our issues on me. He left us on my son's second birthday when I was three months pregnant. With no biological family in Arizona, I went through my pregnancy alone, relying on my church family for support.

My son faced many changes during this time—his father left, we moved apartments, he changed schools, and he welcomed a new baby sister into the world. Managing it all as a single mother was overwhelming. My two-year-old began having challenges in school, and his coordinator recommended I take Conscious Discipline classes to mirror the techniques they used in his Head Start class.

When I saw all the Family Education classes Child Crisis Arizona offered, I decided to sign up for as many as I could. It was one of the best decisions I've ever made.

The classes and support groups provided me with tools to be a better parent and helped me create a village of support. I brought my baby daughter with me to every class, including virtual ones, and learned strategies to help my son navigate his emotions and transitions. Most importantly, I found the courage to stop procrastinating and file for divorce from my husband, who is now in prison.

One of the most profound lessons I learned was the power of choice. I realized the incredible impact I have on my children and the importance of thinking about the long-term effects of my decisions. This awareness helped me reflect on my upbringing and commit to raising my children in a way that empowers them to make thoughtful choices. I now practice self-awareness and model it for my son, teaching him how to communicate effectively and navigate his emotions.

These classes have created a unique sense of community for me—a place where people from all walks of life come together to share, learn, and support one another. It's a space that feels like home, providing not only resources but also understanding and a sense of belonging.

To Child Crisis Arizona: thank you for creating this safe haven. Thank you for the knowledge, the community, and the grace you've given me as I grow as a parent. You've made a lasting difference in my life, and for that, I am forever grateful.

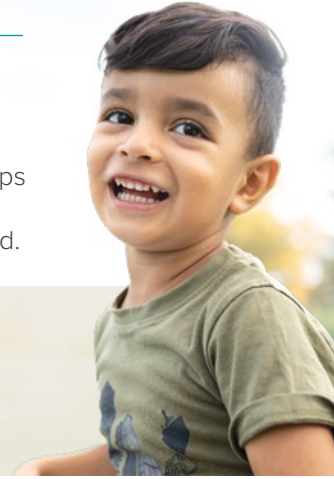
