THIS IS ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE McCAFFERY ASSOCIATION

Two of the most important jobs in the McCaffery Association are being held by Bill Maslak and Harold Faulkner. **FINDING REPLACEMENTS FOR THESE SHIPMATES IS AN IMPORTANT PRIORITY FOR THE CONTINENCE OF THE ASSOCIATION.** Bill keeps track of the members of the Association and researches many areas to try to find those who served on the McCaffery and are not on the list of shipmates.

A lot of the searching is done on the phone and on the internet and with the availability of sites for searching names the job takes tenacity. Computer programming knowledge is not required or necessary.

We also need two volunteers to maintain the program used to keep our reunion roster up to date. One volunteer will be the lead volunteer (do most of the work) and the other volunteer will be a stand-by to help in emergencies or to take over if the lead man is incapacitated. The database is the heart of the Association and Bill and Harold have done a magnificent job of maintaining the database over the years. We use a data base management system called Filepro, from Fp Technologies, to maintain our roster. Our roster contains one record per person. Each record contains as many fields as needed. The fields are: name, address, phone number, rank, years aboard, wife's name, etc.

The volunteers will have to know some sort of programming language. Fortunately, the program we are using uses a simple form of basic programming language, plus it has its own set of features. With this program we can, of course, add new members, make necessary changes as they occur, print any information we desire, sort the printouts by any field we choose (such as last name, state, zip code, etc.). If you feel an obligation to the memory of McCaffery (DD860 DDE860), as we members of the committee do, please volunteer, WE NEED YOU!
