Come to our environmental festival to help release thousands of young chum salmon into Noons Creek, sending them off on their journey to the inlet and beyond before they return in 4 years!

Fish release will take place at the hatchery, which is a short walk over the wooden footbridge behind the Port Moody Rec. Centre Ice Rink (300 loco Road). Take a look inside our hatchery where we have been incubating the chum since the fall and see the fish-rearing coho pond outside.

Inside the ice rink, our exhibitor fair will showcase over 50 environmental organizations, providing education on stewardship and our local ecology. Live performances and music will also be held there throughout the day. Hot dogs, chips, and drinks will be available for purchase at our fundraising food tent outside the rink. 

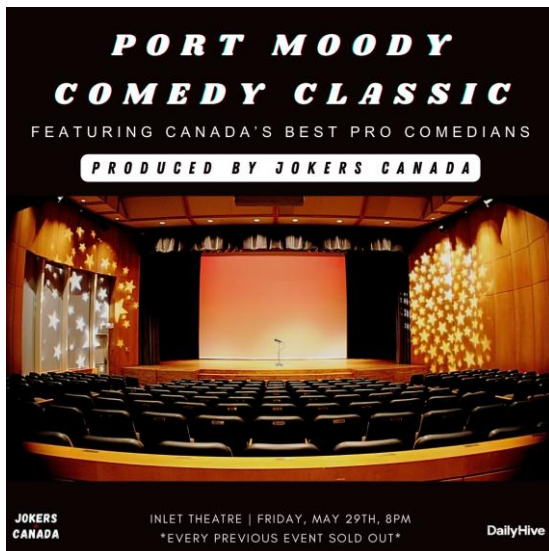
