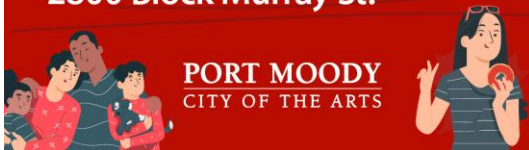

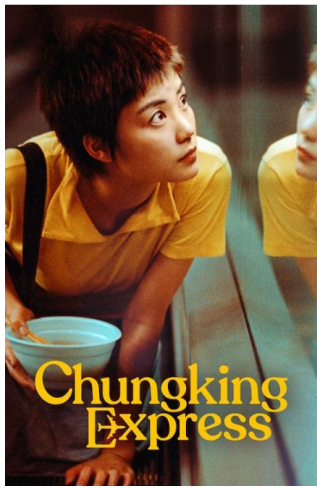

Wong Kar-Wai's movie [Chungking Express](#) about two love-struck cops is filmed with impressionistic splashes of motion and color. It's a minor miracle of modern cinema, a sweet-hearted lightheaded meditation of the ups and down of romantic love that should leave any audience walking on air. This breezy little Hong Kong movie has abundant life, energy, humanity and sheer visual zing – it's the cinematic equivalent of popcorn on a hot stove with jump-cut shots, freeze frames, stirringly beautiful images and boundless energy. Wong's singular frenetic visual style and his special feeling for lonely romantics may remind you of certain French New Wave directors, but this movie isn't a trip down memory lane; it's a vibrant commentary on young love today, packed with punch.

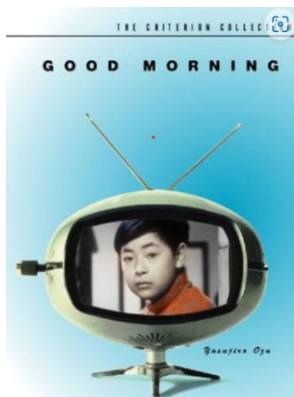

Shot in stunning color and set in a Tokyo suburb where housewives gossip about the neighbors' new washing machine and unemployed husbands look for work as door-to-door salesmen, this charming comedy gently satirizes consumerism in postwar Japan. TriCity Strummers – we’ve moved to Coquitlam’s Dogwood Pavilion!

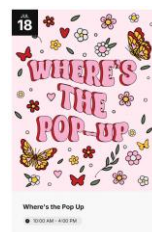
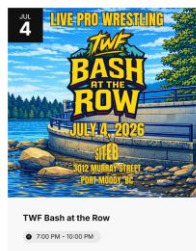

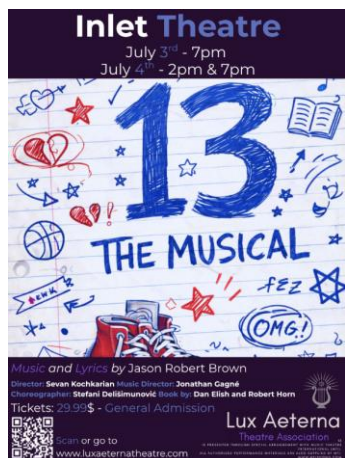
