Manila In The Claws Of Light (at Inlet Theatre)



Julio Madiaga, a simple Pilipino fisherman from the countryside, travels to Manila to find Ligaya, the woman he loves, who went away with a mysterious woman who promised her a better future in the City. When he arrives, he becomes immersed in the city lifestyle and gets involved with its inhabitants, experiencing extreme poverty, hard luck, and the overbearing need to grind for daily sustenance. While Julio relentlessly searches for Ligaya, the city changes him little by little, and he becomes like an animal doomed to live only for survival in a wild, inescapable jungle. With ethical and emotional sophistication, it dramatizes the suffering of the disadvantaged with characters that feel individual yet archetypal. This extraordinary film explores the destructive power of money and urban corruption, how cities like Manila slowly consume the poor. Every institution, from labor to media to law enforcement, fails the characters. Their story isn't rare. It's ordinary. And that's what makes it devastating.

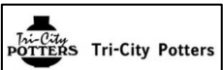
What We Do In The Shadows (at Inlet Theatre)

From director Taika Waititi (*Hunt for the Wilderpeople*, *Jojo Rabbit*) comes the story of Viago, Deacon, and Vladislav – three flatmates who are just trying to get by and overcome life's obstacles, -like being immortal vampires who must feast on human blood. Hundreds of years old, the vampires are finding that beyond sunlight catastrophes, hitting the main artery, and not being able to get a sense of their wardrobe without a reflection, modern society has them struggling with the mundane –

like paying rent, keeping up with the chore wheel, trying to get into nightclubs, and overcoming flatmate conflicts. Rarely does the movie miss a beat, and its cleverness shows itself in a host of ways. It's subtly subversive, subtly satirical, and openly absurd. *What We Do in the Shadows* is bloody good fun.

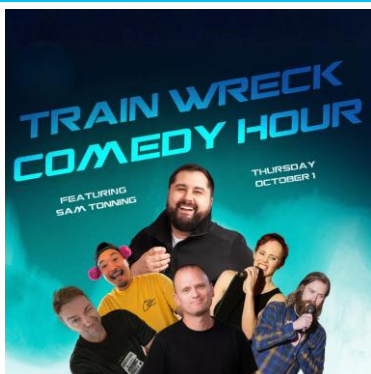

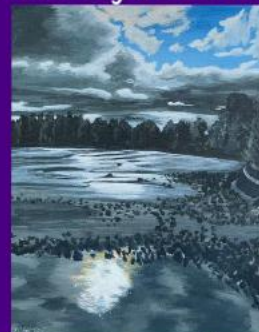
