His other senior roles included commanding 5,500 British troops in Afghanistan, acting as the Army's Director of Communications and serving on its Executive Board, and finally leading the UK's rapid reaction headquarters, held at permanent readiness for global crisis response, until he left the Army in 2022.

Now an established leadership advisor and coach, Rupert works across sectors to support individuals and teams, with a particular focus on helping executives build the leadership tools needed to thrive in today's volatile environment. He has a strong interest in guiding leaders through career inflection points, drawing on his own hard-won insights to offer grounded, practical support.
