UPON the Application of Morning Glory Daycare Ltd. (the “**Company**”) for an Order pursuant to section 64.2(1) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act (Canada) (the “**BIA**”); AND UPON reviewing the Trustee’s First Report, the Trustee’s Supplemental Report dated December 2, 2025, the Affidavit of Myoungshin Lee dated December 3, 2025 (the “**1st Lee Affidavit**”), the Affidavit of Myoungshin Lee dated January 5, 2026 (the “**2nd Lee Affidavit**”), the Affidavit of Myoungshin Lee dated January 16, 2026 (the “**3rd Lee Affidavit**”), the Trustee’s Second Report, filed, the Confidential Exhibit to the 2nd Lee Affidavit (the “**Confidential Lee Exhibit**”); the Notice to the Media of Restricted Access Application; and the Brief of Law of the Applicants and Authorities dated January 5, 2026; AND UPON having heard submissions from counsel for the Applicants, and any other party that may be present;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECLARED THAT:

1. Service of the application is hereby validated and deemed good and sufficient and this Application is properly returnable today.

Extension of Time to File a Proposal

2. Pursuant to section 50.4(9) of the Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act, RSC 1985, c B-3 ("BIA"), the period within which the Company may file a proposal shall be and is hereby extended to 11:59 p.m. (Mountain Time) on March 2, 2026.
3. The general stay of proceedings against the Company imposed by section 69 of the BIA is extended to 11:59 p.m. (Mountain Time) on March 2, 2026.
4. This Court hereby requests the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada or in the United States to give effect to this Order and to assist the Company and the Trustee and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders as to provide such assistance to the Company and the Trustee, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist the Company, the Trustee and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.
5. This Order and all other orders in these proceedings are declared to have full force and effect in all provinces and territories in Canada.
6. The Trustee and the Company are granted leave, from time to time, to apply to further extend the time periods set forth in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this Order.

Sealing Order

7. The Confidential Lee Exhibit shall be immediately sealed by the Clerk of the Court, kept confidential and shall not form part of the public record, and not be available for public inspection until the earlier of:
 - (a) May 23, 2025; or

(b) Further Order of this Court.

8. The Confidential Lee Exhibit shall be sealed and filed in an envelope containing the following statement thereon:
