



Eurythmist or Musician (6h per week on Wednesday term time)

Camphill School Aberdeen offers Colour/Light Therapy for small groups of children and young people with additional and complex needs.

A unique opportunity has come up to join the Colour/Light Therapy team as a eurythmist or musician.

What is Colour/Light Therapy:

Colour, movement and sound are woven together to create a therapeutic experience, which which can be calming for some and stimulating for others.

Colours are produced on a screen by daylight streaming through coloured acetate sheeting. Behind the screen a eurythmist performs movements which cast multi-coloured shadows, in constantly changing patterns, on the screen.

The display that is formed is synchronised with music and poetry performed by a second therapist.

The students sit in the room, surrounded in colour and sound, and have a visual and auditory experience.
