Job Dimensions- Provide music OR Eurythmy to Colour Light group therapy sessions. The job holder will take guidance from the therapist leading the sessions and will be able to contribute to the therapeutic environment and approaches aligned with the ethos and values of CSA.

As a musician you need to be open to play and/or learn the lyre as this is a key instrument in the therapy sessions.

This post requires: A trained Eurythmist or Eurythmy therapist OR an experienced musician playing the lyre, flute, piano, violin, guitar or recorder and open/able to learn to play the lyre.

Key Responsibilities

- Assist the lead therapist in providing music OR Eurythmy for the Colour Light group therapy sessions.

Accountability

- Duties and accountability involving membership of the national PVG scheme.

- Maintaining confidentiality of all information concerning children and young people.
