



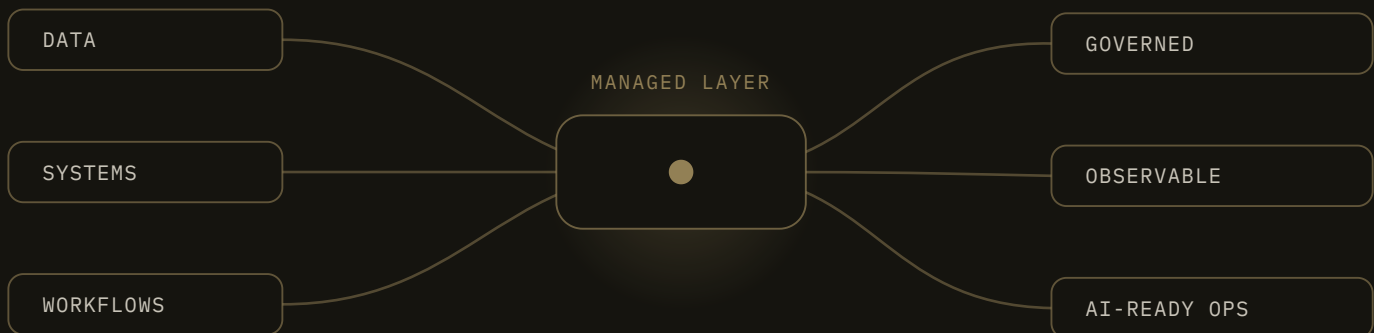

DataExos is an AI-native systems integrator. We design, deploy, and operate the AI, cloud, data, integration, and automation systems that organizations in regulated and high-consequence environments actually have to run — under human authority, on the record, built to mature.



WHO WE ARE

A tool is not an operating capability.

A model that drafts text, a connector that moves a record, a script that fires on a schedule — each is useful, and each is a fragment. The value an organization needs is the system that holds the fragments together: the data they read from, the workflows they live inside, the controls that govern them, and the people accountable for the decisions they touch.

DataExos does more than sell isolated tools. Where a single, well-scoped tool is the right answer, we deliver it — but the heart of the work is the governed operating capability we build around them, so AI, integrations, and automation become something an organization can run, observe, and trust, not just demonstrate.

Built for teams that have to be right the first time.

A pilot that wins a demo and a capability that runs reliably inside daily operations are not the same thing. We build for the second, to a standard we call DataExos-grade: ownership, permissions, data flow, reliability, documentation, monitoring, and human oversight designed in from the start. When a decision carries consequence, the system around it has to be right the first time. That is the work we take.

THE PROBLEM · WHY NOW

AI arrived faster than the discipline to run it.

Most organizations now have AI somewhere in their operations — sanctioned tools, shadow usage, vendor features switched on by default. Few have a way to govern it: a clear view of where AI acts, what it is allowed to commit the organization to, who reviews the consequential decisions, and how any of it can be reconstructed afterward.

Two failure modes dominate. The first is the rigid platform that asks the organization to reshape itself around the tool, treating real constraints — compliance, decision authority, workflows that already work — as edge cases. The second is the long, vague transformation engagement with no defined deliverable and no defined exit, where scope creep becomes the operating model.

The forcing functions are already here.

Boards, audit committees, regulators, and insurers now ask for AI inventories, AI risk assessments, and AI governance documentation that did not exist before. The organizations that move first are not the ones with the most AI. They are the ones who can show where human authority sits, on what record, under what control.

That is the gap DataExos was built to close: operational AI you can stand behind, scoped to where you actually are.

THE DATAEXOS APPROACH · THE EXOSKELETON

The exoskeleton is in the name.

An exoskeleton is a structure that gives an organism strength and support without replacing it. That is how we approach an organization's operation: we add structure around what is already there, rather than asking the organization to become something it isn't.

We assess the people, systems, workflows, data, constraints, compliance needs, and decision points that already exist, then configure modular systems around how the work actually happens. The result is a configurable operating system — one that can include workflows, integrations, data flows, governance, AI agents, documents, portals, dashboards, permissions, and operating procedures — fitted to the organization rather than imposed on it.

"An exoskeleton adds strength to what's already there. It doesn't replace the body — it supports it."

HOW IT WORKS

- 1 Assess what's already there.**
Map the people and roles, the systems in use, the workflows that carry the work, the data that moves through them, and the constraints — regulatory, operational, decision-related — that shape what's allowed.
- 2 Configure modular patterns around it.**
Assemble the system from modular, reusable patterns rather than writing everything from scratch or forcing a fixed package. The result is a configurable operating system, shaped to the organization.
- 3 Operate and evolve.**
The system is built to be governed, observed, maintained, and extended. As the organization changes, the system changes with it — to the DataExos-grade standard — so it keeps fitting the work instead of drifting away from it.

THE DATAEXOS APPROACH · HUMAN-IN-THE-LOOP GOVERNANCE (AETHER)

Human judgment in the loop is the value — not the friction.

The answer in high-consequence work is not to remove people — it is to design the work so people stay accountable for the decisions that matter, with AI reducing friction everywhere it safely can. DataExos builds workflows where human authority is explicit: a named person reviews, approves, or halts; the system gates the consequential action, records the decision, and holds the trail for audit.

We call this system **Aether** — the human-in-the-loop governance pattern DataExos runs its own operations on and deploys for clients. Governance is designed into how the system runs, not documented after the fact.

CONTROL SCALED TO CONSEQUENCE — THREE RISK TIERS

LOW-RISK AUTOMATION

Routine, reversible work. AI acts directly; the system logs every action for visibility.

Posture: observe and sample; intervene by exception.

MEDIUM-RISK AUTOMATION

Real but bounded consequence. AI prepares the output; a defined review threshold determines what proceeds automatically and what is held for a person.

Posture: review threshold + escalation path + named reviewer.

HIGH-RISK AUTOMATION

Decisions about people, money, records, or regulated obligations. An approval gate holds the action until a person approves it; the system records the decision, its inputs, and the approver.

Posture: mandatory approval gate + full audit trail + sensitive-output review.

Capabilities in active development.

DataExos also invests continuously in composable frameworks that deploy *through* engagements — capabilities in active development, not shelf products, described so prospective partners understand the direction of the firm.

VOICE AI PLATFORM

Voice that holds up under compliance review: a composable, provider-agnostic voice layer — multi-channel, telephony-integrable, instrumented for the regulatory regimes clients live under. Configuration, not custom code.

AI ORCHESTRATION (GOVERNANCE-FIRST)

Workflow logic for AI systems that have to behave: a multi-agent decision-and-execution layer that gates consequential steps and holds a full audit trail. Integrates with M365, Google, iPaaS, CRM, and custom APIs.

A GOVERNED KNOWLEDGE LAYER

The knowledge layer other AI systems retrieve from: a knowledge graph, a maintained wiki, and visual navigation, with native source provenance — every retrieval traces to source. Not "RAG over your docs."

A ZERO-TRUST MEDIATION POSTURE

For environments where AI agents cannot have direct, unmediated access to systems and data. We describe the posture, not a shipping product; architecture is discussed under NDA where relevant.

How it composes: a compliant voice channel can front a role-fitted managed agent, grounded in a governed knowledge layer, with consequential steps orchestrated under human review — and, where the regime requires it, sensitive actions mediated under zero-trust controls. The frameworks compose with each other and with your existing stack.

ENGAGEMENT MODEL · THE MATURITY LADDER & THE ECONOMICS

Scoped to where you actually are.

We scope to where you actually are — not where the pitch would like you to be.

Most vendors pitch the top of the curve regardless of where the customer sits — the result is failed pilots. The Enterprise Maturity Ladder closes that gap: every rung has a defined entry diagnostic, a defined scope, and a defined deliverable. You don't skip rungs — you graduate when the business case is clear. Most clients start lower and more concrete than they expect — and that is the point.

THE ECONOMICS HAVE CHANGED

AI has changed the economics: enterprise-class capability — in some cases at 15–25% of historical cost. Our fixed, productized scope passes that change through to you, without the quarter-by-quarter scope creep that open-ended engagements build in.

On the ladder itself, Rungs 1 through 3 deliver the outcomes organizations have historically sourced through large-firm transformation engagements at roughly 60–70% less — lower cost for a comparable outcome. Rung 4 is a full embedded operating partnership at a retainer comparable to the cost of a single senior advisor.

We will not sell you up the ladder. The smallest engagement that solves your real problem is the one we recommend, every time.

The proof is how we run ourselves.

DataExos runs at the top of its own ladder: a six-human senior team, supported by a governed AI agent workforce, running daily operations under human-in-the-loop governance. We climbed rung by rung. We recommend the same.

Proof, not slideware.

We field what we run

DataExos's own governed operation is the working model for what it delivers. A 60+ governed AI agent workforce runs the firm's daily operations under human oversight — audit trails, approval gates, replayable records — alongside a defensible intellectual-property position and a first production voice call on the firm's voice AI platform (April 7, 2026). DataExos has a limited portfolio of client past performance to recite — a founding-stage position by deliberate sequencing — and is deliberately expanding its client base going into 2027.

What the same period produced compounds. Two-plus years of institutional research and hands-on delivery span every major frontier-model family — OpenAI's GPT and Codex lines, Anthropic's Claude family, Google's Gemini, xAI's Grok, the open ecosystems — and AWS, Azure, and Google Cloud, with working judgment on when to use which platform and which architecture, retrieval-augmented generation included. The Strategic Execution Reserve was built in the same period. Client counts measure a sales motion, not systems thinking. Our confidence rests on systems built and run for ourselves, with more planned for public release. DataExos represents validated capability only — it does not represent capacity it cannot deliver.

THE CURRENT PORTFOLIO

The current portfolio, demonstrated live: a governed-workspace platform demonstration for organizations managing key operating metrics — occupancy and utilization, lease and compliance milestones, maintenance and spend, energy — across multiple properties in multiple jurisdictions; and a regulator-facing chemical-examination assistant demonstration that assesses chemical compounds expressed in SMILES structural notation, including PFAS structural screening, as an aid to human review. Both are working systems; neither is presented as client past performance. Alongside them: a deployed instance from a fixed-scope municipal government engagement in Colorado, delivered and in operation. The discipline transfers: the same governance that carries a regulated-agency workflow carries a bank's.

Modernization under scrutiny — with governance designed in.

For federal agencies, state and local government, and public-service teams, DataExos brings AI to the workflows that carry the mission — intake, coordination, and reporting — with human authority and an audit trail designed in from the first line. Our posture is **compliance-aware by design — not a certification claim:** built around the controls reviewers expect.

Because these systems are ours and run live, we can dial governance, security gating, and build rigor to the work in front of us.

WHAT GOVERNMENT AND REGULATED BUYERS GET

- **Compliance-aware-by-design delivery** — risk-tiered human-in-the-loop control, approval gates, and audit trails on every consequential action.

For larger or schedule-driven engagements, DataExos's Strategic Execution Reserve extends delivery without diluting control. It includes a vetted, multi-decade software-engineering partner with regulated-industry delivery (banks, hospital networks), and — distinct from it — a vetted, Arlington-based program and project-management partner that extends delivery and oversight capacity on agency work. Both are distinct from DataExos's in-house AI and architectural core, which is never delegated. A surrounding network of relationships extends reach into adjacent domains, so scope extension is a sourcing question, not an unknown.
