



SUMMER PACKING LIST!

Here are a few reminders/recommendations as you prepare to send your child to camp this summer:

Sunscreen: Your camper should arrive at camp with sunscreen on. We will reapply during the day, but they must come with it already on. Bug spray can also be packed and applied throughout the day.

Bathing Suits: Campers should arrive with a bathing suit under their clothes and are ready for the day. An extra bathing suit can be packed to change in between swim times. Pack extra towel and extra clothes just in case.

Footwear: Your camper should arrive at camp wearing sneakers. We allow campers to change into flip-flops or water shoes for swim and other water activities, please pack in their bag!

Snack: Send your camper with a snack in a separate bag from lunch! Snacks will not be refrigerated, so make sure it is something that can stay in their bag. Snacks should be small and easy to eat!

Lunch: Pack your camper's lunch in a brown paper bag, labeled with your camper's name, group, and if there are any nuts in the bag. Lunches are stored in the fridge and could potentially get misplaced, so this will help keep track! My Hot Lunchbox is available If you prefer to order lunch and have it delivered.

Label Everything! Goggles, towels, clothes, and water bottles get lost very easily, so make sure anything you are sending is marked with camper's name and group.

Pick-ups and early dismissals: Please send a note with your camper, or submit a note electronically through the parent dashboard, if something different is happening for pickup, or if they are getting picked up early. This can mean that your camper is going home with someone else or taking the bus when usually does not. Make sure to let the camp office know something different is happening as well. If there is no note and no one in the office knows, we will have to follow the regular pickup procedure for your camper.

Gadgets or anything of value: All personal belongings stay at home. This includes cell phones, any other electronics, fidget toys, jewelry, etc. Things at camp get lost, and we would hate for your camper to lose anything of value. Cell phones and other electronics are not allowed at camp!
