Climate Action Week Sydney 2025 was our biggest and boldest yet. With 246 events across Greater Sydney, we doubled last year's program and brought a powerful energy to every corner of the community. From grassroots workshops to high-impact industry panels, the week created space for conversations, commitments and real collaboration.

Over 12,500 tickets were sold across 93 venues, with attendees joining us from 54 countries. Our media reach extended to 5.76 million, helping push the climate conversation well beyond the rooms we gathered in.

This wasn't just about scale — it was about momentum. Most significantly, 71% of our audience were first-time participants. That figure tells a bigger story: Climate Action Week Sydney is growing the climate movement, welcoming in new voices and building a broader, more engaged community ready to take action. This is only the beginning of Climate Action Week Sydney's impact.


